TOPIC OF THE COURSE

Studies conducted in the last 20 years have shown that the assessment of spontaneous movement quality and especially of general movement (GM) is an early and reliable indicator for diagnosis and prognosis of neurological disorders in the fetus, newborn and young infant. Aim of the course is to provide a theoretical basis of this new approach to neurological assessment discovered by Prof. Heinz Prechtl and, especially, to train doctors and therapists to the use of this technique for clinical and research purposes. The course is mainly made of projections of clinical material and practical exercises aimed to learn how to assess typically developing infants and infants with brain lesions by this technique. The course fulfils the standards specified by the GM Trust.

PROGRAMME

The course will open on Monday June 6th and close on Wednesday June 8th, 2016, each day from 9.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m.

BASIC COURSE will consist of lessons, demo-sections and discussions about video-recordings. Practical sessions that are the main part of the course will be in English or Italian (in different groups according to the preferred language of the participants). All lessons will be in English.

Main topics of the lessons:

- Development of GMs in pre and post-natal period
- Clinical relevance of GMs study
- Neurophysiological basis of GMs, normal and abnormal
- Main abnormalities of GMs
- GMs and cerebral lesions
- Comparison between GMs analysis and traditional neurological assessment
- Methodology of GMs study in clinics
- GMs and cerebral palsy
- GMs and other neurological and psychiatric disorders
- GMs and systemic diseases

ADVANCED COURSE will provide an additional intensive training in correcting judgement. This training will deal with details of assessment, the proper terminology and technique as well as the application of the individual developmental trajectories. Participants are kindly asked to bring their own video-material (developmental trajectories of selected GMs and good quality recording are recommended). The time reserved for each participant to show his/her own material will be agreed in advance with the organizer. All lessons and practical sessions will be in English. Participation to the advanced course is reserved only to individuals who successfully passed a GM trust basic Training Course.

At the end of the course there will be an Evaluation Test
